Backing Up Your Data

De-installation

As your move day gets closer and closer, it's time to start cleaning house. Dispose of all old or broken equipment and return any leased equipment you no longer need. Instruct your team how to properly shut down their devices the night before your big move to reduce the risk of damages. When it comes to moving your technology, it's recommended you hire office relocation services such as DMS to handle your IT.
